Information – Rules

Downriver First Responders Tug-A-War will be competed over Reflection Pond in Young Patriot Park to find Downriver's strongest Police or Fire Department.

Entry Fee: Free, Must Pre-register with Riverview Recreation by June 12, 2018

Team Size: 10 person team + coach – 8 members of the team will pull at a time

Tournament: Single elimination – One pull per match, Final matches will be 2 out 3 pulls

Prizes: Winning team will receive trophy for their Department

All finalists will receive a prize from the Riverview Summerfest

Donation Collection: All teams are encouraged to bring a boot or hat to collect for a charity of choice during the event.

Rules:

Rope: Will be 1 ½ inch manila rope with proper length for teams and to stretch over the pond

Number of Pullers: 8 pullers per match. Team may have ten members and one coach.

Shoes: Must wear athletic shoes with no spikes. (Gym, Tennis, Running, Cross training, etc.)

Hold: All pullers must use bare hands. Hold shall be with both palms face up and the rope must pass between the body and the upper part of the arm. Rope may not be wrapped around hands, arms or body. No loops or knots can be made in the rope. Anchor may not wrap the rope around them.

Stance: All pullers must be standing on feet. Feet must be extended forward of the knees and the team members should be in pulling position at all times.

Marks: Each side of the pond will have a mark that the first puller in line must start on.

Side: A coin flip will take place before each match. Winner will chose which side they will pull from. The final match team will switch sides after each pull.

Winning: The rope will be marked in the middle. The winning team will pull the middle mark past the markers in the pond in order to win or if a member of the opposing team goes in the pond.

Judge: The judge will have final say of rules and match decision.
