**9.1 AUTHORIZE THE PREPARATION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, THE SOLICITATION OF BIDS AND PERFORMING CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION, INSPECTION, TESTING, MARKING, AND AS BUILT MEASUREMENTS BY CHARLES E. **COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND:** The City of Riverview intends to undertake a city owned sidewalk replacement program in 2018. The Department of Public Works is requesting authorization for Charles E. Raines Company to prepare plans and specifications and authorization to seek proposals for this project and to perform contract administration, inspection, testing, marking and as built measurements. The sectioning funding breakdown is as follows:

Funds have been allocated in the appropriate accounts for the 2018 sidewalk replacement program subject to approval by the City Council.

Raines Company to prepare plans and specifications, to seek proposals for this project and to perform contract administration, inspection, testing, marking and as built measurements for a cost not to exceed **\$36,210.00**.

**10.1 ADOPT RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CITY’S REPRESENTATIVE TO THE DOWNRIVER UTILITY WASTEWATER AUTHORITY (DUWA) TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE DEFINITIVE TRANSFER AGREEMENT THAT HAS BEEN NEGOTIATED WITH WAYNE COUNTY FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE DOWNRIVER SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM-CITY MANAGER.**

**COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND:** The Downriver Utility Wastewater Authority (“DUWA”) is comprised of thirteen communities (including Riverview) that utilize the Downriver Sewage Disposal System (“System”) for treatment of sewage. Since 2016, negotiations have been ongoing for DUWA to assume ownership of the System from Wayne County.

Recently, a Definitive Transfer Agreement (“DTA”) has been agreed to between the parties, and consultants for DUWA are attending community meetings to present the DTA and answer any questions.

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Adopt resolution to authorize the City’s representative to the Downriver Utility Wastewater Authority (DUWA) to vote in favor of the Definitive Transfer Agreement that has been negotiated with Wayne County for the purchase of the Downriver Sewage Disposal System.

**12.1 AUTHORIZE SECOND READING, BY TITLE ONLY, AND ADOPTION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 702, AMENDING MINOR IN POSSESSION ORDINANCE SECTION 38-392 REGARDING ALCOHOL – CITY ATTORNEY.**

**COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND:** Michigan Legislature enacted two bills PA 33, 2016 (SB 357) and PA 89, 2017 (HB421). The changes took effect on 1/1/2018. Both affect the Minor in Possession ordinance.

The first amendment (PA 33, 2016) reduces the first time penalty from a misdemeanor to a civil infraction while the second and subsequent offenses continue to be misdemeanors.

The second amendment (PA 89, 2017) prohibits the administration of a preliminary breath analysis if a minor does not consent to it, but it allows a police officer to seek a court order for such a test.

The ordinance amendments would bring the current ordinance in line with current case law and practices.

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Authorize Second Reading, by title only, and adoption of Proposed Ordinance No. 702, Amending Section 38-392, in regards to Minors in Possession of Alcohol.
