The City of Riverview is seeking interested applicants for the following Boards and Commissions:

BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION – 2 VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Promotes a spirit of civic pride through residents and businesses. Meets second Tuesday of month at 6:00 p.m.

BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS - 1 VOLUNTEER REQUIRED: Authorizes special approval of buildings and permits. Meets the second Thursday of month at 7:30 p.m.

CITY OF RIVERVIEW BUILDING AUTHORITY - 3 VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Members acquire, furnish, own, improve, and operate and maintain building(s) for use by the City. Meets May and October at 7:00 p.m.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION/BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY - 2 VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Encourages economic development and revitalization. Meets quarterly and one annual meeting at 6:30 p.m.

PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION - 3 VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Recommends programs for implementation. Meets first Wednesday monthly at 7:00 p.m.

PLANNING COMMISSION – 1 VOLUNTEER REQUIRED: Advises Council of physical development in the city including streets, parks, etc., creation of the Master Plan and proposed changes in the zoning ordinances. Meets 1st and 3rd Thursdays at 7:30 p.m.

RETIREMENT BOARD OF TRUSTEES – Responsible for the administration, management, operation and carrying into effect the provisions of the retirement system. Meets monthly on the fourth Thursday at 7:00 p.m.

RIVERVIEW HISTORICAL COMMISSION - 6 VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Accepts documents, photos, artifacts, etc., relating to historical development or preservation.

SENIOR RECREATION COMMISSION - 5 VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Formulate, plan and implement programs and special events for the older population of the City. Meets second Tuesday of month at 10 a.m.

BOARD OF CANVASSERS – I DEMOCRATIC PARTY VOLUNTEER REQUIRED: Members canvass the election returns of nominees elected to public office, and determines the vote on all referendums and propositions on the ballot and declares the adoption or rejection of same. Meets the day following any municipally related election at 3:00 p.m.

BOARD OF REVIEW – Members work with tax rolls and assessments. Meets February, March, July and December.

LIBRARY COMMISSION – Establishes and maintains the public library including staffing and budget. Meets monthly on the third Thursday except July and August at 7:00 p.m.

LOCAL OFFICERS COMPENSATION - Determines the salaries of elected officials. Meets odd-years only at 4:00 p.m.
