City of Riverview Travel Policy

The purpose of the Riverview Senior Travelers Program is to provide a safe and enjoyable diversified travel program for residents 55 years and older. You do not need a travel partner to participate.

SCHEDULING: All trips will be scheduled through the Riverview Recreation Department.

REGISTRATION: Registration will be in person at the Recreation Office. You may register other seniors for the trips but you must have their name, address and phone number at the time of registration. On trips subsidized by the City of Riverview, a \$5.00 non-resident/non senior club fee will be charged. Registration is on a first come basis. Waiting lists will be created when necessary. Residents will have the first week to register. After that, non-residents may sign up.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY: Refunds are available on day trips if the spot can be filled from the authorized waiting list. Refunds on overnight trips are determined by the tour company. You **must** notify the Recreation Department of all cancellations.

EMERGENCY INFO: All travelers are asked to keep on their person, a medical card containing emergency numbers, allergies, medication, etc.

TRIP DEPARTURE: All trips depart from the Riverview Municipal Building unless otherwise stated. We ask travelers to arrive 15 minutes prior to the trip's departure.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS: Travelers are responsible for their own personal belongings (packages, camera, etc.)

ASSISTANCE: If you need personal assistance on any city-sponsored trips (one-day or extended) because of a physical or visual handicap, please register with a friend who can act as your personal escort. City of Riverview escorts must ensure the safety and comfort of the entire group. They cannot act as personal escorts for an individual attendee during a trip.

WAYNE COUNTY CHORE PROGRAM

Funding from Wayne County for the Chore Program allows for services such as lawn mowing, leaf raking and snow removal. In addition, minor home repairs and home care installations (ramps, grab bars, etc.) are also provided. The Senior Alliance is granted funding via contract by Wayne County to provide the above named services. The contract covers the cost of the services for many individuals. And for those whose income falls above the minimum guidelines, they are only requested to make a small donation. The amount that is requested will be determined by the services rendered and the client's income. Individuals who are within the income guidelines will receive the services free of charge.

CHORE REFERRAL PROGRAM

The Chore Referral Program helps seniors and the disabled to receive home care services for a reduced fee. This service is based off a list that can be mailed to clients. The chore workers are like independent contractors and they are willing to carry out these services and have been interviewed, references checked and put through a criminal background check. The services and prices for the chores are agreed upon by clients and the chore worker before the work is carried out. This program **does not** authorize personal care, transportation or medical care. Chore referral services include: mowing, light house-keeping, yard clean up, wall washing, gutters, window washing, gardening, light electrical, plumbing, light carpentry, painting, snow shoveling, leaf raking and errands/shopping (client is **NOT** to be transported).
