A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING FILM STUDIO PROJECT
TO BE LOCATED IN THE CITY OF ALLEN PARK

WHEREAS, economic times are handing a financial blow to the Downriver Communities on a scale that has not been seen since the Great Depression with no relief in sight; and

WHEREAS, our Downriver Communities are directly affected by the challenges confronting the beleaguered automotive industry; and

WHEREAS, our Downriver Communities would benefit from the diversification and existence of a new industry that appears immune to the present recession; and

WHEREAS, each Downriver Community, its businesses and its residents would benefit from such a major employer being located within our immediate vicinity;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council for the City of Riverview supports of the proposed Film Studio Project to be located in the City of Allen Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by this Resolution, the City of Riverview requests that the Wayne County Executive Robert Ficano and the State of Michigan to proactively commit their resources, services and finance-based incentive programs in assistance to the City of Allen Park to make this opportunity a reality; and
