AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 38-162 OF ARTICLE V, "OFFENSES INVOLVING PUBLIC PEACE AND ORDER" IN CHAPTER 38, "OFFENSES AN MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS" TO ESTABLISH LIMITS ON AMPLIFIED NOISE.
