## CITY OF RIVERVIEW PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 599

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW BY AMENDING SECTION 46-74 OF ARTICLE III, LAND PRESERVE, UNDER CHAPTER 46, TO ADD SLUDGES, INDUSTRIAL PROCESS WASTES, AND OFF SPECIFICATION MATERIALS TO THE LIST OF MATERIALS THAT ARE ACCEPTABLE AT THE RIVERVIEW LAND PRESERVE.

THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW ORDAINS:

ARTICLE I. Adoption: That Section 46-74, Acceptable Waste, be amended to hereafter read as follows:

Section 46-74. Acceptable waste.

- 1) The following types of special waste may be accepted at the Land Preserve upon adoption of this ordinance:
  - a) Impacted soils;
  - b) Treated wood and wood products;
  - c) Sludges;
  - d) Industrial process wastes; and
  - e) Off specifications materials.
- 2) The landfill equipment operators' collective bargaining agent shall be notified about the acceptance of special wastes by the Director of Solid Waste or the Director's designee.
- 3) Sludges, industrial process wastes and off specification materials shall be referred to the Land Preserve Committee for recommendation, and shall be subject to approval by the City Council prior to acceptance. Contracts for disposal of such materials shall contain provision for termination in the event of nuisance conditions that the City deems unacceptable in its sole discretion.

ARTICLE II. Penalty: A person violating this ordinance shall be punished in accordance with Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Riverview, unless a different penalty is expressly provided in this ordinance.

ARTICLE III. Severability: Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction or by any agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holding shall be construed and limited to such word, sentence, phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be invalid and shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of the Ordinance.

ARTICLE IV. Conflicting Ordinances: All prior existing ordinances adopted by the City of Riverview inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.

ARTICLE V. Reading and Publication: This Ordinance shall be given a first reading on November 6, 2006, shall be given a second reading on November 20, 2006, shall be adopted on November 20, 2006 and shall be published and become effective upon publication. The Clerk shall publish a summary of this ordinance and include in the publication notice that a true copy of the Ordinance can be inspected or obtained at the Clerk's office.
