- Bid Award and Execution of Agreement with **Trinity Cars, Inc.**, for **Senior Transportation** at a rate of **\$12.00** per one-way trip within boundaries; **\$39.00** per one-way trip within boundaries for handicap accessible and **\$2.50** per mile outside of boundaries.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 618

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW BY THE REPEAL AND RE-ADOPTION OF SECTION 66-1 OF ARTICLE I "IN GENERAL" IN CHAPTER 66 "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES" TO ALLOW FOR THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE TO BE ADOPTED BY REFERENCE AND UPDATED AUTOMATICALLY BY FUTURE AMENDMENT.

Motion by Councilmember Coffey, seconded by Councilmember Rudicil, that the City Clerk be authorized to give the **First Reading**, by title only, of Proposed **Ordinance No. 619** regarding **Storm Water Management System** to prevent pollution from storm water runoff and protection of the quality of waterways in the city.

Carried unanimously.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 619

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW BY THE ADDITION OF ARTICLE V. "STORM WATER MANAGEMENT" IN CHAPTER 70 "UTILITIES" TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT AGAINST POLLUTION FROM STORM WATER RUNOFF; TO PROVIDE FLOOD CONTROL AND ADEQUATE DRAINAGE WITHIN AND AROUND THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW; TO PREVENT POLLUTION WITHIN AND AROUND THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW; TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF STORM WATER CONSTRUCTION APPROVALS FOR CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW'S JURISDICTION; TO PROVIDE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION CRITERIA FOR STORM WATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS; TO PROVIDE FOR ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE; TO REQUIRE LONG-TERM MAINTENANCE AND FINANCIAL ASSURANCE TO AUTHORIZE INSPECTIONS OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES GOVERNED BY THIS ORDINANCE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF ALL PRE-EXISTING LEGAL REQUIREMENTS TO PRESERVE AND PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT; TO PROVIDE FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THIS ORDINANCE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF; AND TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.
