TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Presidential Primary Election will be held in the City of Riverview, State of Michigan, on Tuesday, February 28, 2012, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 8:00 PM prevailing Eastern Time to elect the following:

- Candidate to the Democratic Party
- Candidates to the Republican Party

THE FOLLOWING SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPOSAL WILL ALSO BE VOTED ON:

Shall Riverview Community School District, Wayne County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Forty Three Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$43,260,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of: erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to the High School and Middle School; partially remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing, equipping and re-equipping the High School, Middle School and elementary schools; acquiring, installing and equipping educational technology for school facilities; constructing, equipping, developing and improving athletic facilities and playfields; constructing a storage building; and developing and improving sites? The following is for informational purposes only: The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2012, under current law, is 7.32 mills (\$7.32 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 11.93 mills (\$11.93 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). If the school district borrows from the State to pay debt service on the bonds, the school district may be required to continue to levy mills beyond the term of the bonds to repay the State. (Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
